When Jesus says: “Come to me” (Matt 11:28) he offers us an abundant and complete life. But do not become discouraged. Every Christian suffers the pain of failure at one time or another in his or her spiritual life. Therefore we must always remember this promise: No matter how many times you break your commitment to Jesus, his wonderful invitation remains. He invited you: “Come to me! “And when you go back to him, he welcomes you with open arms.
