

He died for you

When Jesus had tasted it (the sour wine), he said, "It is finished!" The he bowed his head and released his spirit (John 19:30).

Read John 19: 28 – 33

Jesus was the all sufficient and final offer for the sins of man. In this context the word "finished" means the same as "paid in full". Jesus came to fulfill God's salvation work, to finish it (John 4:34; 14:4). He paid the full price for our sins. Thus, his death, seen from a Christian perspective, put an end to the Old Testament sacrifice system, because he made atonement for all our sins. Through Jesus' death we can approach God. We are free from the sin that kept us from him before Christ's death.

A deaf-mute boy wrote on his slate for his teacher to see: "I cannot understand how Jesus alone could die for all people." The teacher thought for a moment, went outside and came back, her apron filled with dead leaves. Then she took the diamond ring from her finger and weighed it up against the leaves. The boy's face brightened up and then he wrote on his slate: "Now I see it. Jesus is a diamond, much more precious than all the dead leaves in the world. That is why he could pay the price for all our sins." Can you say in all sincerity, "He died it for me?"

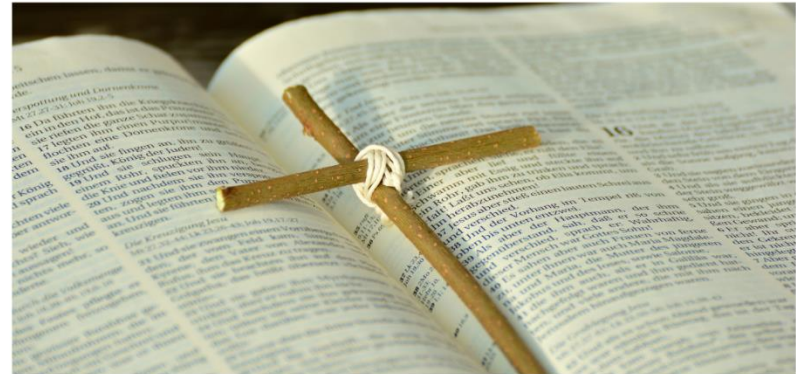
